222. May the Eucharist be administered to non-Catholic Christians also?

Holy Communion is the expression of the unity of the Body of Christ. To belong to the Catholic Church, one must be baptized in her, share her faith, and live in union with her. It would be a contradiction if the Church were to invite to Communion people who do not (yet) share the faith and life of the Church. It would damage the credibility of the sign of the Eucharist. [1398 - 1401]

223. In what way is the Holy Eucharist an anticipation of eternal life?

Jesus promised his disciples, and us with them, that we will one day sit at table with him. Therefore every Holy Mass is a “memorable of the blessed Passion” (Eucharistic Prayer I, called the Roman Canon), the fullness of grace, and a pledge of future glory. [1402 - 1405]

The Sacraments of Healing The Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation

224. Why did Christ give us the sacrament of Penance and the Anointing of the Sick?

Christ’s love is shown in the fact that he seeks the lost and heals the sick. That is why he gave us the Sacraments of healing and restoration, in which we are freed from sin and strengthened in our physical and spiritual weakness. [1420 - 1421] 67

225. What names are there for the sacrament of Penance?

The sacrament of Penance is also called the Sacrament of Reconciliation, of forgiveness, of conversion, or of confession. [1422 - 1424, 1486]
