The Seven Sacraments of the Church The Sacraments of Communion and Mission

248. What are the names of the Sacraments that serve to build up communion in the Church?

Someone who is Baptized and confirmed can receive moreover a special mission in the Church in two special sacraments as and thus be enlisted in the service of God: Holy Orders and Matrimony. [1533 - 1535]

The two Sacraments have something in common: They are directed to the good of others. No one is ordained just for himself, and no one enters the married state merely for his own sake. The sacrament of Holy Orders and the sacrament of Matrimony are supposed to build up the People of God; in other words, they are a channel through which God pours out love into the world.

The Sacrament of Holy Orders

249. What happens in Holy Orders?

The man who is ordained receives the gift of the Holy Spirit that gives him a sacred authority that is conferred upon him by Christ through the bishop. [1538]

Being a Priest does not mean just assuming an office or a ministry. Through Holy Orders a priest receives as a gift a definite power and a mission for his brothers and sisters in faith. 150, 215, 228, 236

We have always tried to expose our deaf children to both communities. As their parents, we have talked to them and tried to answer their questions when they saw someone using sign language and they had basic sign language books. Then one day our oldest son, Ethan, said he would like to learn sign language. We discover Silent Voice's Sign Language Summer Camp and enrolled him in the program. The following year Gavin joined his older brother and they both want to go again. We also put our name in for the Family Communication program because we wanted to support our children. These opportunities increased the boys awareness of the deaf community and also helped them gain respect for different ways of communication. They enjoyed both experiences as did we. We all hope to take part in the Family program again. Last year more than 600 deaf children received support through Silent Voice's Sign Language Summer Camps.
