38. How does the Church see the media?

The media are necessary building blocks of modern societies. They are not ends in themselves; rather, as social means of communication, they serve people and help themselves to understand one another. The media - and those who make them available and distribute them - have an ethical responsibility. They must direct their activity toward the goal of mutual understanding: What fosters this understanding, what impedes it? How can man and his social relations be promoted? What developments serve the common good, for example, the free exchange of news and opinions? The Pontifical Council for Social Communications, which founded in 1948, deals intensively with the questions: 1) How can the faith be proclaimed in an appropriate way in the media? and 2) How are the media to be used "correctly"?
