103. For a believer, what is the most radical reason to practice solidarity?

The solidarity of Jesus. No one ever practice greater solidarity than Jesus. Jesus was sent as the living sign of God's solidarity with mankind, which cannot help itself. The Son of God not only declares his solidarity with all mankind; he even lays down his life for us. This definitive self-giving for the sake of others represents the highest possible love and solidarity and should become the standard for Christian action.

104. Are the principles of social doctrine the only foundation on which to build a good society?

No. Christian social doctrine is naturally tied to general values that logically precede it. I must have sound values and commit myself to them personally in order to lead a conscientious life and be able to participate reliably in society. The social principles are then guidelines for shaping society. All values, in turn, are connected with the dignity of the human person, as a primary value that results from man's likeness to God.

105. What values are important in social doctrine?

Three values are fundamental: truth, freedom, and justice. Yet truly successful human coexistence requires in addition love and mercy. And so Thomas Aquinas says: "Justice without mercy is cruelty; mercy without justice is the mother of dissolution."
