THE FAMILY

117. What does the family do for the individual?

To experience family is extremely importance for the individual human person. Ideally it is the place where he is born and grows up. In the family he experiences for the first time communion with others who by their very nature wish him well and unreservedly love and respect him. In such a positive atmosphere, every family member can develop his capabilities and acquire the strength to face whatever life may bring. That is precisely the purpose of an education based on a Christian view of the human person. At the same time, the individual persons in the family experience what it means to take responsibility, since a family member cannot simply live for himself alone. Consequently, every role - whether that of the parents, the grandparents, or the children - always has its duties as well toward the other family members.

118. Does the family also contribute something to society?

Yes, everything that the family accomplishes internally, for itself and for its own members, is socially relevant, too. After all a society can thrive only if things go well for individual members of society, if they feel loved and appreciated. In the family, one can learn that prior to the marketplace logic of exchange there is an entirely different kind of give-and-take, a logic of self-giving and acceptance. The fact that individuals also learn in the family the meaning of social responsibility and solidarity likewise benefits society as a whole: someone who proves to be responsible and to practice solidarity "in little things" will be more likely to do so "in big things", too. Where does one learn devotion to the poor, the sick, or the elderly better than the family? Where does one better understand people who are desperate, lonely, or abandoned? How does a person become sensitive to structural social ills if his own family does not set an example? The family thereby makes an irreplaceable contribution to the "humanization of society" (C. Kissling).
