# FROM: <u>DOCAT</u> <u>Power and Morality</u> The Political Community

### 220. Must the Church agree with all democratic decisions?

The Church's option in favor of democracy does not mean that she also must agree with all decisions that a democratic society makes. In her ethical judgment she often takes a stand opposed to the decisions of elected officials. For example, can the Church approve of legalized abortion or research on human embryos? The Church has the duty to criticize such developments. Here Christians are required to become actively involved in politics, to stand up for the values of the human rights and the sanctity of human life, and to convert them into political decisions.

# 221. Does the Church therefore have reservations about democracy after all?

The Church reserves the right to distance herself critically from all forms of political organization. She prefers and supports democratic forms of government, but she does not idealize them. Democracy, too, is a system that is not impervious to mistakes and errors. Catholic social doctrine is concerned about the fundamental ethical principles of social life and not about "technical questions" of political organization.

# 222. How far is the rights of the majority extend in a democracy?

If the fundamental value of every political community is the human person, then even democratic or legislative majorities cannot justly make any political decision whatsoever. Politics is inseparably connected with law and rights, especially with fundamental personal and civil rights. These must never be denied to minorities. Of course this creates duties, too, for the minorities, even if they feel that they are not represented in the political decisions.
