The Issue of Fair Trade

251. What problems arise in regard to worldwide trade?

In the wake of globalization, trade relations between countries throughout the world have also become closer. This has helped some countries; in many others, nevertheless, it has aggravated social and ecological problems. Of course, in selecting my purchases as an individual consumer, I have very few opportunities to influence the way trade is structured. Therefore it is important for national governments to deal with this problem or else for organizations to be founded that advocate trade structures that are more just.

252. What is fair trade?

Fair trade refers to commerce that is conducted according to definite principles of justice (fairness). Various fair trade organizations determine these principles and coordinate the trade relations. They promote greater justice in international trade inasmuch as they strengthen the rights of the producers (such as small farmers and plantation owners) and contribute to a sustained development in the countries in question. In order to achieve this, they commit themselves to a dialogue between the trade partners, to greater transparency about production and trade relations, and also respect for all the actors involved.

253. What measures are taken to promote fair trade?

First, opportunities are created for economically disadvantaged producers to take an active part in the trade system in the first place and to become more independent. Socially just production methods, good work conditions (pay, hours, prohibition of child labour, etc.), and also equal rights for women are fostered. At the same time, environmental standards are developed. Long -term "partnership" relations between countries should also be established.
