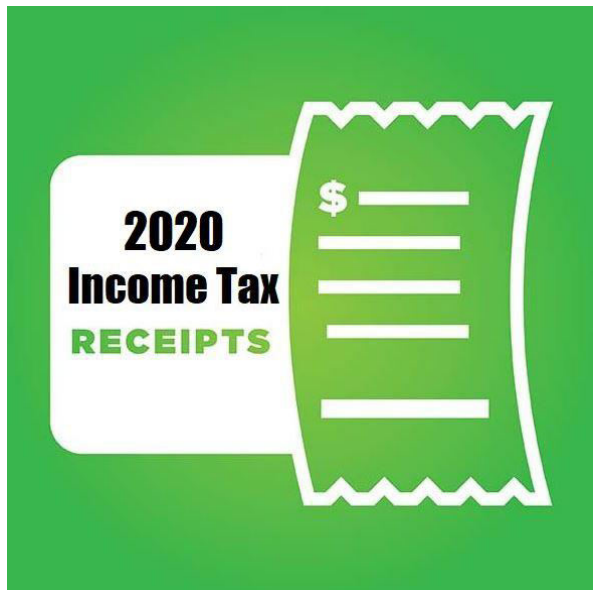

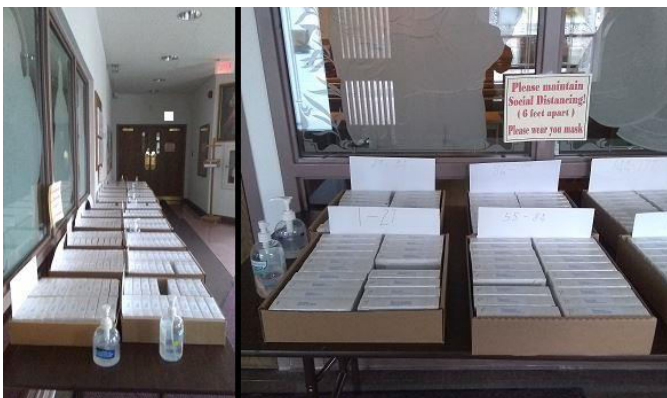
Income tax receipts for 2020

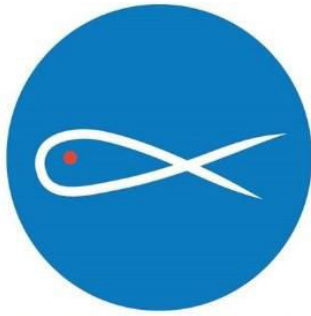
Being Hospitalized during Lockdowns

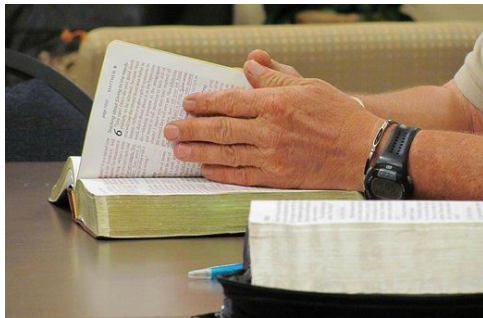

Sunday Communion Services
will Continue

Our Communion Services will only take place on Sundays from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm. No need to pre-register, just print your name and contact info when you arrive. **Note only ten people allowed in the church building at any given time**, which means you will have to wait outside the church building until enough people have exited. Please maintain social distancing. If it is cold or there is a long line, you may need to stay in your cars to stay warm.



How Not to receive Holy Communion

Some people have started the practice of turning away when consuming Holy Communion. They are doing this out of respect for the one giving Communion, so as to not spread germs when they remove their mask. **This is not a good practice!** It is **essential that the communicant receives Communion in front of the Minister, in such a way that it is clear to the Minister of Communion that the Sacred Host has been consumed.** Such practices as turning away, once they become commonplace, will only make it easier for Satanists to steal consecrated Hosts.



Stations of the Cross During Lent

One great way to deepen our spiritual life during Lent is praying the Stations of The Cross and Rosary every day. To help us, the following groups have organized these at our parish **every Friday at 7:00 p.m. on Zoom**; please note time on Good Friday (April 2nd):

- **February 19** - Parish Youths
- **February 26** - Catholic Women's League
- **March 5** – Knights of Columbus
- **March 12** - St. Vincent de Paul
- **March 19** - Legion of Mary: Living Rosary (Day of Solemnity - no Way of The Cross)
- **March 26** - Legion of Mary: Way of The Cross
- **April 2 (Good Friday)** - Way of The Cross at **6:00 pm**, followed by Scriptural Rosary



Ash Wednesday is on February 17

Ash Wednesday, like Good Friday, is a day of Fasting and Abstinence from meat. **The law of abstinence from meat is binding on those who are 14 and older. The law of fasting is binding on those who are 18 to 59 years of age.** The requirement for fasting is that you can have one full meal and two other small meals in such a way that the two small meals don't add up to a full meal (and of course, no meat). If required, you may drink beverages between meals, but not something that is very filling (such as a milkshake).

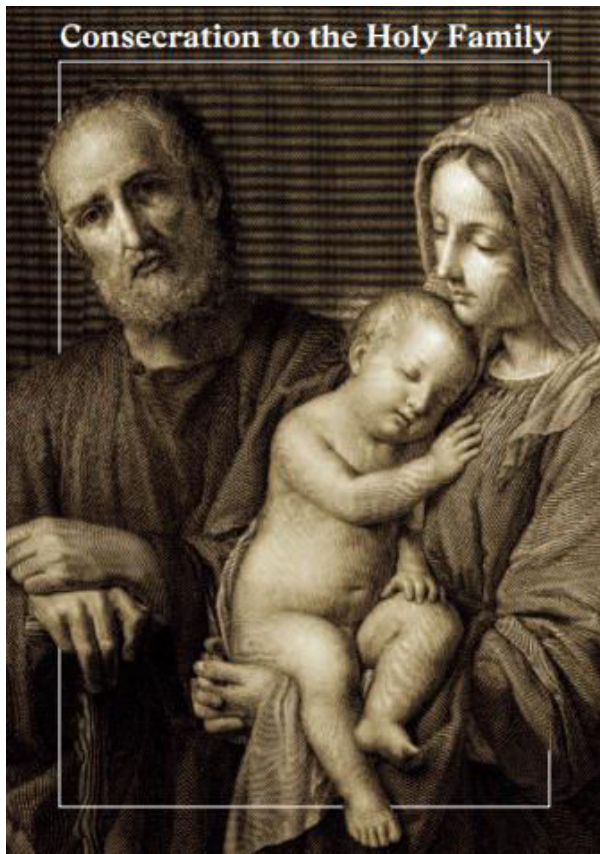
Holy Communion and Ashes will be distributed:

- **Wednesday February 17** from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm **and** from 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm.

Ashes only will be distributed:

- **Thursday February 18** from 12:00 noon to 12:30 pm (**no Holy Communion**).
- **Friday February 19** from 12:00 noon to 12:30 pm, **and** from 8:00 pm to 8:30 pm (**no Holy Communion**).
- **Saturday February 20** from 12:00 noon to 12:30 pm (**no Holy Communion**).

Note that there will be no prayer time during the distribution of ashes.
