The holy water dispenser is on the left-hand side of the church, close to the pieta statue.




Disaster Relief for India

Pope asks Catholics to pray for an end to the Pandemic


Pope Francis has invited Catholics around the world to dedicate the month of May to a marathon of prayer for an end to the Covid-19 pandemic.
