Can you find your way through the cloud maze?



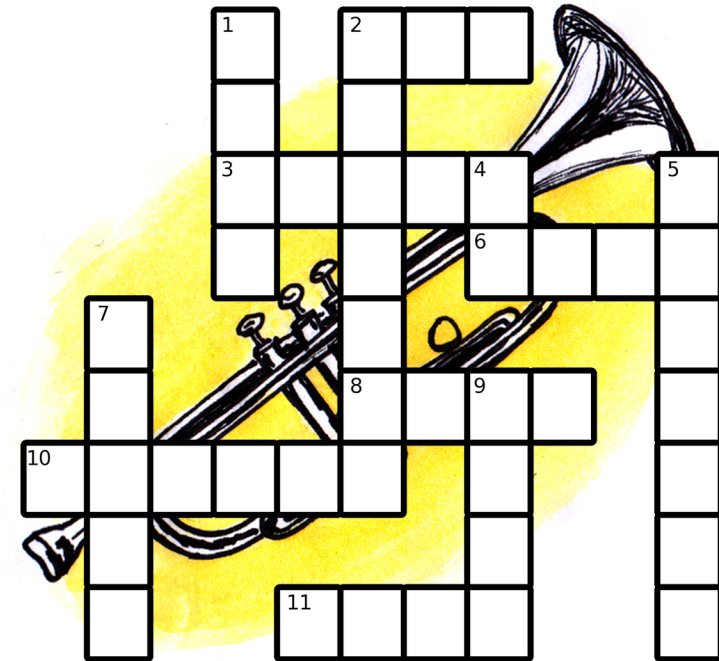
Saint Rita of Cascia
