




Disaster Relief for India

Only parishioners, or regular attendees, should Some have expressed opposition to moving the tabernacle to the centre. It was suggested that we provide some of the reasons for either option and that we allow people to sign a petition to keep the tabernacle where it is. We hope to have this available on our website as soon as possible.



Holy Water

We are not permitted to use the holy water fonts at the entrances of the church but you can take holy water home, to use in your own homes. Holy Water is a good source of obtaining more of God's blessings and warding off evil. You will need to bring your own bottle or container. The holy water dispenser is on the left-hand side of the church, close to the pieta statue.
