We are returning to our regular Mass times schedule. For Weekday Masses just show up and sign in. **Once we reach 75 people inside the church, we have to lock the doors.** For Sunday Masses, you need to pre-register. **Online registrations begin Tuesday morning at 6:00 am for the coming Sunday Masses.** Note that there is an **overflow registration** for those who were not able to pre-register for the coming Sunday. If you weren't able to sign up for the coming Sunday but add your name to the overflow, we will try to give you first preference for the following Sunday. Make sure you are signing up for the right weekend. If for some reason you can't make it for the Mass you signed up for, please be considerate enough to indicate the change, and make your spot available for others. Instructions are provided on the website how to do this. You can only sign up for yourself and your immediate family living with you. You cannot sign up for relatives or friends. After Sunday Masses, if you can help sanitize the pews, it would be very much appreciated.

Steven will bless your car and the people in the car. **The intentions will be prayed over at the Mass the following day on Sunday June 13th, the Feast of St. Anthony.** Remember to write your intentions/petitions before you come to the drive by.

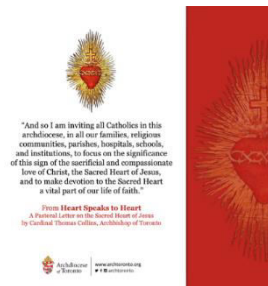

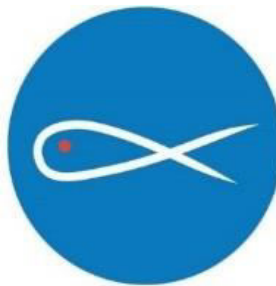


Quality Family Time Contest
