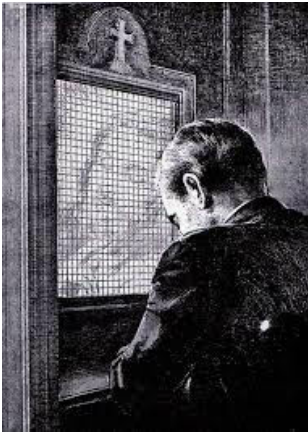

There is no limit on how many people we can have at Mass, but we have to maintain strict social distancing, which limits how many people we can accommodate. For Sunday Masses you will need to continue to pre-register. Online registrations begin Tuesday morning at 6:00 am for the coming Sunday Masses. We can also use the Hall for Sunday Masses. For Weekday Masses just show up and sign in when you arrive. If for some reason you can't make it for the Sunday Mass you signed up for, please be considerate enough to indicate the change, and make your spot available for others. Instructions are provided on the website on how to do this. You can only sign up for yourself and your immediate family living with you. You cannot sign up for relatives or friends. After Sunday Masses if you can help sanitize the pews as well as the chairs in the Hall, it would be very much appreciated.

The theme announced by his Holiness Pope Francis for the first **World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly on Sunday July 25th**, is “I am with you always” (Mt. 28:20).
