New Policy from the Archdiocese regarding vaccinations

The Archdiocese is encouraging everyone to be vaccinated, but respects everyone's personal decision. The new policy indicates that all clergy, staff and volunteers participating in the Mass must be vaccinated or provide a negative test result prior to participating at Mass. This is to be monitored by the Parish and the Archdiocese. These measures are intended for everyone's safety. *People's vaccination status is something that is personal and should not be spoken of to others.*



Simbang Gabi Novena of Masses - December 16-24

The Filipino community of St. Aidan's Parish would like to invite everyone to embrace their "beautiful gift" of Simbang Gabi. This is a Filipino Christmas tradition; a series of nine dawn Masses on the days leading up to Christmas, from December 16th to December 24th. The tradition goes back to colonial times, during Spanish rule, when Catholic priests started offering Mass very early in the morning so that farmers could attend morning Mass and still be at work before sunrise. Join us in preparing for the birth of Our Lord through this novena of prayer and sacrifice by participating in the nine Simbang Gabi Masses from December 16-24 at 6:00 am, at St. Aidan's church. After each 6:00 am Mass, a reception of coffee/tea and traditional Filipino foods will be available to eat or bring home. Everyone is welcome.

Remembrance of your deceased loved ones

During the month of November, we are called to remember our deceased loved ones and pray that they be released from Purgatory. **We will have a box at the front of the church.** You can place the names of your loved ones on a piece of paper or envelope and drop it into the box. All the Masses celebrated in November will include everyone whose names are in the box.



Gaining an Indulgence for your Deceased Loved One

Normally for the first 8 days of November you could gain a plenary (or full) indulgence for your deceased loved ones by visiting a cemetery and fulfilling the other requirements, which are: praying for a deceased person at the cemetery, praying for the Holy Father's intentions, receiving Holy Communion on that day, going to confession within a period of twenty days before or after the indulgenced act, and being detached from all sin, including venial sin. If you are not detached from all sin, you would only gain a partial indulgence. This ability to gain a plenary indulgence for a deceased loved one has been extended by Pope Francis for the entire month of November due to pandemic restrictions. Gaining an indulgence would enable your deceased loved one to pass through Purgatory much sooner.
