
Children's Christmas Liturgy

Confessions, Christmas and New Year's Schedules (2021/2022)

Parish Confessions Tuesday December 14

We will have three priests available for confession on <u>Tuesday December 14th, from 7:00 pm</u> to 9:00 pm inside St. Aidan's Church.

<u>Catholics are required to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.</u> Christmas and New Year's are Holy Days of Obligation. Attending one of the Christmas Eve Masses, on the 24th, fulfills your obligation for Christmas. Attending the 5:00 pm Vigil Mass of New Year's, on December 31st, fulfills your obligation for New Year's. Note that for those who have valid reasons for not coming to Mass, the dispensation from Cardinal Collins is still in effect. You will need to pre-register online for these obligation Masses and for the Sunday Masses. Registration will begin on the Tuesday prior for Christmas, New Year's and Sundays.




Simbang Gabi Novena of Masses - December 16-24

The Filipino community of St. Aidan's Parish would like to invite everyone to embrace their "beautiful gift" of Simbang Gabi. This is a Filipino Christmas tradition; a series of nine dawn Masses on the days leading up to Christmas, from December 16th to December 24th. The tradition goes back to colonial times, during Spanish rule, when Catholic priests started offering Mass very early in the morning so that farmers could attend morning Mass and still be at work before sunrise. Join us in preparing for the birth of Our Lord through this novena of prayer and sacrifice by participating in the nine Simbang Gabi Masses from December 16-24 at 6:00 am, at St. Aidan's church. After each 6:00 am Mass, a reception of coffee/tea and traditional Filipino foods will be available to eat or bring home. Everyone is welcome. Note that you will need to pre-register online for these Masses. Registration is accessible at this time.
