

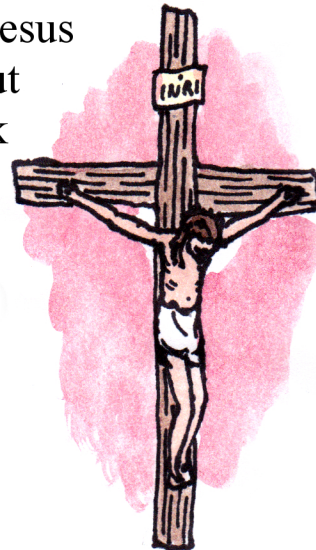
# Looking at Jesus

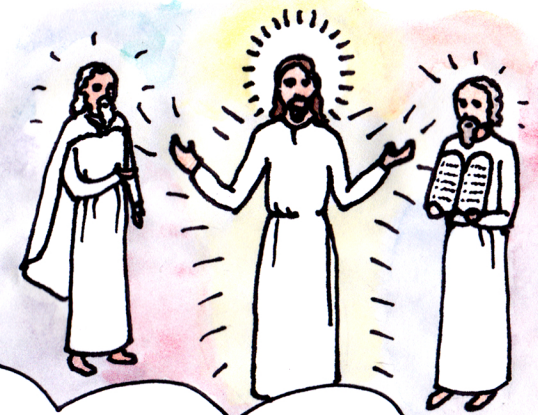

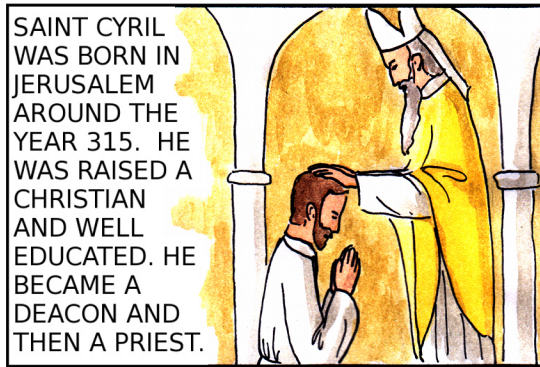

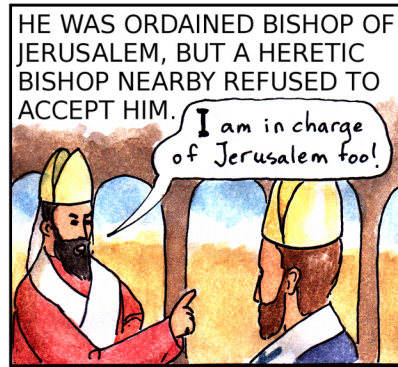

# SAINT CYRIL OF JERUSALEM

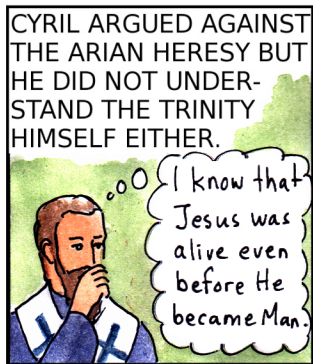
MARCH 18

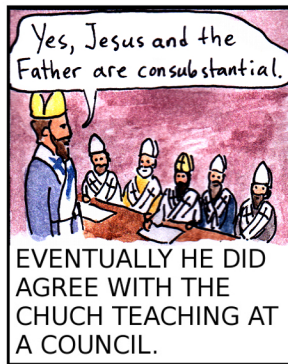

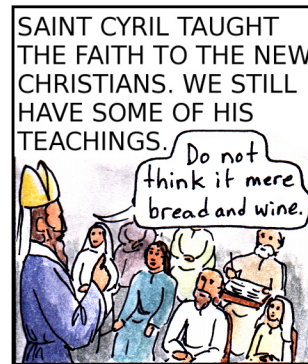
