### End of Mask Mandates

The provincial government announced the end of public masking requirements in most nonmedical settings effective <u>Monday, March 21</u>. The Archdiocese of Toronto has followed the Government of Ontario's Covid-19 guidance throughout the pandemic. <u>As such, our churches,</u> <u>halls and offices will also no longer require masking starting on Monday, March 21</u>. Some people will still want to wear masks in churches and offices, and they should not be discouraged from doing so.



Pope Francis to Consecrate Russia and Ukraine in union with the Bishops and Faithful around the World

Pope Francis will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on <u>Friday</u>, <u>March 25, at 5:00 pm Rome time, which is 12:00 noon our time</u>. This is very significant since Our Lady of Fatima asked for the consecration of Russia in union with all the bishops of the world, so that there may be peace. *You are invited to make this prayer of consecration on Friday, March 25 at 12:00 noon*. We will make it available once we have the text. We usually have adoration on Fridays till 12:30 pm, so the church will be open till then. <u>Fr. Steven will</u> <u>lead those present in the prayer of consecration at 12:00 noon</u>. He will also lead the faithful in reciting the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary at 11:30 am.



Humanitarian Aid for Ukrainians

The war between Russia and Ukraine continues. Donations to help Ukrainians who are suffering due to this war and have had to flee their country are being accepted. The Archdiocese of Toronto will channel donations to support the **Office for Refugees**, **Archdiocese of Toronto (ORAT)** and the **Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA)**. CNEWA is a papal agency with a long history of humanitarian relief; it is currently working in Eastern Europe, providing Ukrainians with food, shelter, medicine and transportation to safe locations. ORAT is Canada's largest private Sponsorship Agreement Holder, which helps bring hundreds of newcomers to our country each year; it will use donations to bring Ukrainian refugees to Canada as soon as possible.
