

All Night Vigil of Adoration on First Friday, April 1st

This can be done to make reparation for the sins of mankind, to gain graces for oneself and others, and to grow in one's relationship with God. *For security reasons, we will lock the church doors during the night*. Adoration will end just before the morning Saturday 9:00 am Mass.



Why Christianity?



The in-person talks will begin at 7:00 pm at St. Aidan's church, and will also be live-streamed for those not able to attend in person. The first talk will be on Monday April 4 at 7:00 pm, at St. Aidan's church. The topic is: Who is Jesus?



Humanitarian Aid for Ukrainians

The war between Russia and Ukraine continues. Donations to help Ukrainians who are suffering due to this war and have had to flee their country are being accepted. The Archdiocese of Toronto will channel donations to support the **Office for Refugees**, **Archdiocese of Toronto (ORAT)** and the **Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA)**. CNEWA is a papal agency with a long history of humanitarian relief; it is currently working in Eastern Europe, providing Ukrainians with food, shelter, medicine and transportation to safe locations. ORAT is Canada's largest private Sponsorship Agreement Holder, which helps bring hundreds of newcomers to our country each year; it will use donations to bring Ukrainian refugees to Canada as soon as possible. Yes, there has been a change as to when this will be done. You are invited to make this prayer of consecration on Friday, March 25 at 1:30 pm in union with Pope Francis and many others. Fr. Steven will also lead the faithful in reciting the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary at 1:00 pm. The text of the consecration will be available on our parish website, and in our church. We usually have adoration on Fridays till 12:30 pm, but this Friday adoration will continue until 5:45 pm. At 6:00 pm we will have the Living Rosary, led by the Legion of Mary. There will be no Adoration in the evening, at the usual 6:00 pm to 7:15 pm time slot.

Income tax receipts for 2021 are ready



Our Food Bank Project runs until June 30, 2022. Right now, we have another 65 kilograms of food packed and ready for delivery, and we intend supporting a second food bank, this one at the Scarborough Centre for Healthy Communities on Eglinton Ave East.

If you are interested in live streaming a church event, we are asking for \$300 to help us cover the costs of purchasing, maintaining and running the equipment.




Synod on Synodality
