Email and Phone Scam

Please be aware that the Archdiocese has received multiple reports of fraudulent emails targeting our parishes, parishioners and departments. The scammers are posing as priests, and even bishops of our Archdiocese. Often they ask that the recipient email back in order to discuss a favor. They will often ask for gift cards to assist someone in great need. To protect against scams, please change your email password regularly. If you receive a suspicious email, or text, from someone you know or someone who is requesting gift cards or money, please contact them on a trusted phone number to ensure they actually sent you the message. No priest, nor anyone from the Archdiocese of Toronto will ask you for a gift card. If the sender's information seems odd or if the message is out of character for the sender, do not reply to the message.
