Group Visit to a Cemetery

On Saturday November 2nd, which is the commemoration of all the faithful departed, you are invited to join Fr. Steven for a visit to Pine Hills Cemetery, 625 Birchmount Rd. We will need to carpool for those unable to drive. We will meet close to the cemetery office at 1:30 pm. November is dedicated to the faithful departed. From November 1 to 8 a plenary indulgence can be gained for your departed loved ones by visiting a cemetery. The usual conditions for gaining a plenary indulgence apply: namely, perform the indulgenced act, sacramental confession (any time within the period of 8 days before or after), receive Holy Communion, pray for the pope’s intentions and detachment from all sin. If not fully detached from all venial sin, a partial indulgence is gained.
