## Sunday Mass Time Change

Starting Sunday July 5 our new and permanent Sunday Mass schedule will be 8:30 am, 10:30 am, 12:30 pm. Please be sure to adjust your alarms if this affects your regular routine of coming for Sunday Mass.

## Away on Pilgrimage

Fr. Steven will be away on the yearly CWL pilgrimage to the shrines in Quebec. He will be away from Sat. June 27 to Tues. June 30. The Mass schedule will be the same as usual, with visiting priests coming in to celebrate Mass each day.

## Availability for Confession

We usually have confession available for 20 minutes before all Masses and on Saturdays from 4 pm to 5 pm. All of us are encouraged to go to confession regularly. For those who may be handicapped and cannot access the confessional, you can arrange to meet with Fr. Steven in his office. Note that Fr. Steven needs to leave the confessional 5 minutes before weekday Masses, and 10 minutes before Friday evening Mass.

## First Friday

Our next first Friday is July 3. After our Friday evening 7:30 Mass we will have an All-Night Vigil of Adoration. Everyone is invited and encouraged to participate, even if it is just for a short period of adoration.

## Access to the Parish Hall from School

For those of you who have to park at the school for Sunday Masses, please note that we will start unlocking the hall doors that open directly towards the school parking lot. This will make it easier for you to enter into the church or hall directly from the school parking lot.

## Totus Tuus Summer Camp
