Sunday Mass Time Change

Starting Sunday July 5 our new and permanent Sunday Mass schedule will be 8:30 am, 10:30 am, 12:30 pm. Please be sure to adjust your alarms if this affects your regular routine of coming for Sunday Mass.

Away on Pilgrimage

Fr. Steven will be away on the yearly CWL pilgrimage to the shrines in Quebec. He will be away this Sat. July 27 to Tues. June 30. The Mass schedule will be the same as usual, with visiting priests coming in to celebrate Mass each day.

Availability for Confession

We usually have confession available for 20 minutes before all Masses and on Saturdays from 4 pm to 5 pm. All of us are encouraged to go to confession regularly. For those who may be handicapped and cannot access the confessional, you can arrange to meet with Fr. Steven in his office. Note that Fr. Steven needs to leave the confessional 5 minutes before weekday Masses, and 10 minutes before Friday evening Mass.

Access to the Parish Hall from School

For those of you who have to park at the school for Sunday Masses, please note that we will start unlocking the hall doors that open directly towards the school parking lot. This will make it easier for you to enter into the church or hall directly from the school parking lot.

Totus Tuus Summer Camp

Canada Day Celebration

Knights of Columbus, Bishop Greco Assembly invites the parishioners and friends to a Canada Day celebration on Wednesday July 1st at St. Aidan Church. It will start with a parade around the church's ground at 10 am followed by address and blessings of our Faithful Friar Fr. Steven Szakaczki and a welcome address by SK Bernard Alvarez. After the singing of O Canada, refreshments will be served in the church's hall.

First Friday

Our next first Friday is Jul 3. After our Friday evening 7:30 Mass we will have an All - Night Vigil of Adoration. Everyone is invited and encouraged to participate, even if it is just a short period of adoration. Those who observe the first Friday devotion, for nine consecutive months, by receiving Holy Communion on those Fridays, with the intention of making reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, for the many offences committed against Him, will receive the grace of final penitence and they shall not die in disgrace or without receiving the sacraments. The divine Heart of Jesus will be their safe refuge in their last moments. This has been revealed by Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1674 and has been a part of the Church's devotional practice since then. An additional requirement is that you go to confession within the period of 8 days before or after the First Friday

Turning Right from Parking Lot

Due to limited parking spaces for everyone, we ask that when driving out of the parking lot, you only turn right, especially after Sunday Masses. Do not turn left, you will be holding up cars behind you. If you need to go left, turn right and you can go around the block or you can pull into the front of the school next door where they have a roundabout, and you can turn left from there. Also try not to stop traffic in front of the church by dropping people off or picking them up. It is an act of kindness for you to want to do that for your loved one, but it is also an act of kindness towards other parishioners that you do not block the flow of traffic.
